HALAM PARISH COUNCIL - NOTES OF THE MEETING ON THURSDAY 8TH JANUARY 2009

Present: S Bust, A Fraser, D Herbert, G Herbert, A Paris & M Thompson **Apologies:** Mrs Di Parrish
Matters arising 1. Interactive speed sign not working – has been reported 2. Sinking road by Gray Lane junction – being monitored by NCC Highways Department 3. Wet on Radley Road at top end, near Oxton Road – NCC Highways Dept. to investigate old drains 4. Parish Plan letter to N & S District Council – still no response; clerk to contact District Council 5. Recent accident on corner near Strickland Farm – a record of this and other accidents to be kept to aid in road safety improvements 6. **Christmas Tree – the tree was vandalised just before Christmas. It is very disappointing that the lights were pulled off and broken. The Parish Council would be very interested to receive any information about this unkind and pointless action.**

Village Hall - Mrs Thompson & Mrs Herbert will prepare costed schedule of works and will report back

Design Statement - Andrew Paris circulated a draft Village Design Statement. Comments from other councillors to be given to Mr Paris by 18th January. A final draft will be presented to the next meeting (February)

BT Phone box - It was reported that the Parish Council agreed at the last meeting to purchase the Halam phone box, and to maintain the current electricity supply and lighting

Open Meeting - No matters raised

Correspondence - Strategic Housing Land Availability Assessment – a letter and plan have been received from N & S District Council outlining land in the parish that they consider may be suitable for future development. A Paris to prepare a response stating the technical reasons why certain sites would be unsuitable for such development.

Planning

Demolish existing conservatory and erect single storey sun-lounge to rear, and two storey lounge and bedroom extension to front – Little Oak, Radley Road: rejected 3 to 1 (with 2 abstentions) with the comment to be put on the application form that the Parish Council had concerns about the loss of privacy of the adjoining property due to an overlooking window in the new extension

Planning Decisions

1. Ashcroft House, Gray Lane – formation of ménage: approved
2. Strickland Farm, The Turnpike – erection of single and two storey extension to form annex (retrospective): approved
